The Central and State Government are now easing up restrictions and are opening the Lockdown in phase-wise manners with Guidelines published from time-to-time. Taking in to consideration the importance of Continuous Learning for Nurses and also abiding by the Guidelines of Government to avoid large congregations, Maharashtra Nursing Council in its CNE Committee Meeting dated 13<sup>th</sup> September 2020 has resolved to conduct the CNE's through webinar, so as to exercise physical/social distancing and to ensure convenience for Nurses.

The Guidelines for webinar will override the CNE Guidelines published by Maharashtra Nursing Council on its Website dated 03<sup>rd</sup> January 2020 till further such Orders.

## WEBINAR GUIDELINES

- The Webinars will be conducted by Maharashtra Nursing Council and the Organizations affiliated to Maharashtra Nursing Council for the said purpose.
- The Schedule for Webinar will be published on the website of Maharashtra Nursing Council.

### 1. GUIDELINES FOR NURSES

- The Nurses must earn minimum of 20 credit hours till 2022, in order to be eligible for registration renewal.
- The fees for webinars will not be charged from the participant Nurses.

### 2. GUIDELINES FOR ORGANIZERS

- The webinars must be ‘Need based’, and are to be planned with theoretical and practical sessions, wherein the different procedures should be demonstrated to the participants.
  - The duration of a webinar shall be a minimum of 40 minutes to a maximum of 2 hours.
  - The webinar must be conducted free of cost and the participants shall not be charged any fees.
  - The Honorarium for the resource persons would be ascertained by the CNE committee as and when proposed and will be decided upon case to case basis.
  - The Honorarium for the observers are waived off for the webinars.
  - The Council will keep a tab on the webinar and the needed technical support will be assured.
  - The above mentioned revision in the CNE guidelines will have an overriding effect on the existing CNE Guidelines published by Maharashtra Nursing Council on its website dated 03<sup>rd</sup> January 2020 till further such orders.

Note:- Any other authority/organization who are willing to conduct webinar for Nurses in the periphery should approach Council, whereby after scrutiny, Council would undertake all financial assistance.
